

STREET FOOD VAN POLICY – USE OF THE CRINGLEFORD PARISH COUNCIL CARPARKS

Cringleford Parish Council

Introduction

Cringleford Parish Council regularly receives requests to use its carparks as a location for a street food van. This policy has been put in place to manage these requests.

General.

- A maximum of two vans will be allowed to pitch at any given time at The Willow Centre and The Jubilee Centre, and must offer different food types. The Parish Council Administrator will keep a record. Due to carpark size, one van at a time to be allowed at the Pavilion.
- All vans will need to supply a copy of their insurance, their food hygiene certificate and their hygiene rating before being allowed access. Food hygiene ratings **must** be at least 4 stars. A traders' licence, if required, must be shown.
- Any trailing cables, wires etc must be clearly marked, and covered with cable protectors.
- The hirer must provide their own bin for their customers. All rubbish must be taken away..
- If a van requires water / electricity from CPC buildings this will only be available on occasions where the buildings are open. Staff will not be brought to site on occasions where buildings are not open. This means access may be cancelled at short notice if a booking is cancelled.
- Parish Council staff have the final say on any matters of Health and Safety, and the location of the van.
- The booking can be terminated with a minimum of one week's notice by the Parish Council at any time.

Fees.

The following fees* will apply and must be paid by BACS at least 24 hours before the booking. The maximum length of a single booking is 5 hours.

- First booking – free for pitch only. £5 if requiring electricity / water

Thereafter:-

- Pitch only: £10 per booking/reservation.
- Pitch requiring electricity / water: £15 per booking.

*Fees may be reviewed annually.
