Roadworks. As most readers will have noticed, work has started on Roundhouse and Thickthorn roundabouts in preparation for improvements. Highways have informed us that Roundhouse roundabout will become partially signalised and a controlled pedestrian crossing will be placed between the roundabout and bus interchange. The works will take until August this year. Preparatory work is already underway for the Thickthorn improvements. Details of both roadworks can be found on our website under 'News', and here:
